CPLED Alberta's Program has two parts with each part offered twice per year. Each student is required to complete both parts within one CPLED year (July 1, 2010 – June 30, 2011). The order in which the two parts are completed is within your, and your firm's, discretion. Each Part consists of:

Rows include: Interviewing and Advising (oral), Legal Research and Writing, Advising (written) and Writing, Drafting (litigation pleadings), Oral Advocacy; and Drafting (wills), Drafting (contracts), Negotiation, Professional Responsibility and Ethics, Practice Management.

The dates for each Part are offered as follows:

- Part I – July 26 to October 7, 2010
Part II – October 7 to December 23, 2010
Part II – November 11, 2010 to February 10, 2011
Part I – February 14 to April 29, 2011

Student registration will be based on receipt of their Application at CPLED's Alberta office on a first come first serve basis. Your registration will be conditional upon your meeting the CPLED Program admission requirements set out in your confirmation letter. You will not be permitted to participate in the CPLED Program unless you are a member of the Law Society of Alberta or otherwise under its regulatory jurisdiction. All CPLED Program admission requirements must be met by the date indicated in your confirmation letter, failing which your registration will be cancelled.
