FEATURE VOLUNTEER

After graduating from the University of Alberta with her BA in 1996 and her LLB in 2000, Tina was well on her way to fulfilling her lifelong goal of becoming a lawyer. Over the course of her career, Tina has appeared at all levels of Court in Alberta and has practiced primarily in the areas of family law and civil litigation. While her ideal dream job has changed over time, her dedication to the profession and her commitment to volunteering has remained steadfast. In addition to the countless hours of support that Tina has provided to LESA over the years. she has also given back to the profession by working with the Habitat for Humanity Legal Build, teaching Techniques in Negotiation at the University of Alberta, and volunteering at the Edmonton Community Legal Centre (amongst other things!). In the past six months, Tina has generously contributed her time and talent to LESA as an author for the 2014 Family Law Practice Manual update, as a faculty member at our Child Support seminar, and by providing feedback during learning exercises for the CPLED Oral Advocacy module.

What drew you to the legal profession and the practice of family law in particular?

What drew me to law is an impossible question to answer: it's what I've always wanted to do. I said that when I was 5 to my parents, who were a bit baffled by the concept. I wanted to be a Crown Prosecutor. That was the be all and end all goal. But when I was looking for articles the Crown didn't want to hire me, so I went to a general firm and did some family law there. I found that I was more

interested in family law than anything else, but, because of the drama associated with family law, I didn't want to pare off the civil litigation at that point. I wasn't sure how much of the drama I could handle. Then eventually, as I got to do more and more of it, I lessened and lessened all of the civil litigation that I was doing and just focused on family law. I think part of why I enjoy it is the instant gratification of solving a problem. That's one of the things I didn't like about civil litigation: the files took so long to get done. I also enjoy dealing with individuals, instead of companies, and getting to solve a problem for a person.

What advice would you pass on to a newly called lawyer?

Get really good at time organization, and be able to block off time for personal life. It's important to have life, not just law. But also recognize that what you're doing, while it's just a file to you, it's a huge deal for your client. Recognize the gravity of what it is that you're doing for people. Those are the two things that people should keep in mind.

What is the most significant benefit of volunteering?

My own continuing legal education. Writing papers or participating in seminars, [such as] the Intensive Advocacy program, reminds me of the right way to do things. As time goes on I think we tend to get a little bit lazy, because we're used to doing things a certain way and we're used to citing the same cases. Volunteering forces me to update my research and update my skills and remind myself of the things I shouldn't be doing. It makes me a better lawyer.

"Whatever it is that you're passionate about, find some outlet and take some time every year to volunteer. It returns itself to you tenfold."
