Online modules open at 4 p.m. on the start date. This is the earliest that students can access their course work. During a module, online submissions are due before 4 p.m. each Thursday. Deadlines are **strictly** enforced, unless prior approval in writing has been granted.

Students can complete Trust Accounting and Indigenous Canada self-study courses at any time during the CPLED year. To avoid delaying their bar admission, students must obtain certificates of completion by **April 4, 2019**.

* Students must arrange to have an invigilator oversee their Practice Management and Client Relationship Management Competency Evaluations.

Note:

The registration deadline is **May 31, 2018**. Students who do not apply by this date are subject to a non-refundable late filing fee.

Documentation and fees are due **July 27, 2018**. Students whose documentation and fees are not received by this date may have their applications cancelled and/or be delayed entry into the CPLED Program.
