

## CPLED PROGRAM 2019/2020 KEY DATES

Students in the CPLED Program take the following combination of face-to-face and online sessions:

### Face-to-Face

**Interviewing & Advising** (choose 1 of 4):

- Week of February 3, 2020 (Calgary)

Session enrolment is **limited**. Students are encouraged to register early; preferences are granted on a first-come, first-served basis.

Attendance is **mandatory**. Dates are subject to change. Detailed schedules will be sent to confirmed applicants.

Students should **remember to consult** with their articling firms, wherever possible, before making their selections. This helps ensure that session preferences take into account the interests of the principal, the law firm, and the applicant.

<b>Client Relationship Management:*</b>	March 12, 2020 to April 2, 2020
<b>Trust Accounting:</b>	Self-study, due April 2, 2020
<b>Indigenous Canada:</b>	Self-study, due April 2, 2020

Online modules open at 4 p.m. on the start date. This is the earliest that students can access their course work. During a module, online submissions are due before 4 p.m. each Thursday. Deadlines are **strictly** enforced, unless prior approval in writing has been granted.

Students can complete the Trust Accounting and Indigenous Canada self-study courses at any time during the CPLED year. To avoid delaying their bar admission, students must obtain a certificate of completion by **April 2, 2020**.

\* Students must arrange to have an invigilator oversee their Practice Management and Client Relationship Management Competency Evaluations.

The registration deadline is **May 31, 2019**. Students who do not apply by this date are subject to a non-refundable late filing fee.

Documentation and fees are due **July 26, 2019**. Students whose documentation and fees are not received by this date may have their applications cancelled and/or be delayed entry into the CPLED Program.

Supplemental competency evaluations are scheduled during the Reserve Period that runs **April 2, 2020 to June 25, 2020**.
